IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **From the S.A. Edu. Dept.**

1. With Regards to the RNCS, Changes have been brought into the Foundation Phase (Gr. R – 3) during 2004. The Intermediate Phase (Gr. 4-6) and the Senior Phase (Gr. 7-9) are due to be implemented during 2005 and 2006.

2. The RNCS for the FET (Further Education and Training, Gr. 10-12) have been released by the S.A. Edu. Dept. ACE are currently working through these documents in order to align our FET Phase to these Statements. This Phase is to be implemented during the following timeframe: Gr. 10 (2006), Gr. 11 (2007) and Gr. 12 (2008)

3. The last “Matric Examinations” in the current format will thus be administered during 2007.

2. **Biology PACE Sequence 1121-1132.**

Until further development is done, the following interim arrangement is in effect. In order for the learners to understand the concepts in Biology PACEs 121-124, they first need to understand the process of Mitosis and Meioses (PACE 130). For this reason the order of the sequence has been changed as follows: 125-132, thereafter 121-124.

3. **Economics and Management Sciences Grade 9.**

PACEs 100 – 102 have been replaced by a textbook, Accounting Skills Workbook, Grade 9 by Japie Stander. This book may be obtained directly from Japie Stander Education (Tel. no. 011 888 1375, Fax 011 782 0971) at a cost of just R30 a learner. There is also a score key which costs R25. You only need one copy but every learner must have his/her own workbook. This workbook is self-contained. Modules 1-7 of this workbook meet the requirements of the RNCS for this section of the learning area. These modules are therefore compulsory. Modules 8-10 should be done by those students who wish to do Accounting as a Major Subject from Gr. 10 and onwards. Scoring should be done by way of continuous assessment.

4. **MASTER MATHS**

For Math. Gr. 12, the ACE National

Office are revising the SA Math 133-144 PACEs at present. As an interim arrangement, Students that would like to study further at a University, can choose to complete the ACE PACEs, or enroll onto the MASTER MATH Computerised Math Curriculum. It is advised that students commence with Gr. 11 and then progress to Gr. 12 as the ACE PACEs also include Grade 11 and Gr. 12 curriculum. The CD’s from Master Math are R300 per grade level per student. You can phone them at 021 8515660 and speak to Adri. You will need to mention that you are registered with the ACE National Office and quote your customer no. with ACE to qualify for this special offer. The normal price is R1800 per student per grade level.

5. The Educators Convention is from 3-4 March 2005 in Worcester. Remember attendance is compulsory for all Home Schools.

6. Because of the Edu. Conv. there will be no home educators days during the 1 st quarter of 2005.

8. Remember the curriculum increase of 6.5% from the ACE National Office as from 1 Feb. ’05.
