## SENIOR CONVENTION / ALL AFRICA STUDENT CONVENTION

**23 – 27 NOVEMBER 2005. - UNIVERSITY OF THE FREE STATE, BLOEMFONTEIN. - -**  
**EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION R 795. -**  
**REGISTER BEFORE 26 AUGUST**

During the past few weeks, I have sent e mails regarding AASC events to parents of students who are in the age group between 13-18 years old. These students are required by ACE to attend the AASC twice during their high school career.

ACE made this a requirement a few years ago and the convention will be reflected on their Graduation Certificate as they earn a full credit for their participation at this event.

There are events which are purely South African events, and then there are events which students are able to participate in both in South Africa and in the United States should they qualify to attend the International Student Convention in the United States.

The South African Convention was attended by more than 1600 delegates during 2004. The International Convention is normally attended by approx. 4500 delegates from across the globe.

The fee of R795 includes accommodation and 3 meals for the students during their time at the Convention. Please remember that a specific dress and Hair code applies at the convention as students attend this event as a student representing their school.

If at all possible, the plan is to send students from the WCHEA as a group to the convention. This will mean that the Academy will register as a school at the convention and the Registration Fee of Approx. R200 per school will be split between the students that attend. Parents are welcome to register their students as a home school, but must then pay the Registration Fee as a h/s too.

Should we be able to go as a group, we will endeavour to get a vehicle in order for the students to travel together as an Academy. This will obviously save costs, because if everyone travels on their own, the costs will be for their account.

If each home school registers separately, you will have to supply and pay for a sponsor (adult of the same sex) to accompany your child/ren. If we go as an Academy, the sponsor's costs will be split between the students attending. Remember, that way a male and female sponsor may sponsor up to 8 students.

Could I ask if there is any parent that is willing to let us use their Combi for the week of the convention, to please contact me in order for us to know how to arrange the transport up to Bloemfontein and back.

Also remember that the students will probably need some pocket money for food/snacks while traveling to and from Bloemfontein and also during the duration of the convention.

Remember, we are offering help with the conv from the Academy's side. You don't have to go to the Academy, but you will then be responsible for arrangements/registration. We therefore thank your support as we have to meet deadlines in order to make this a successful event. ***Our most important deadline is:***

**MONDAY 22 AUGUST !!!**

By this date I need to know the final events that are going to participate in and proof that full payment of R795 has been made into the AASC bank account. Please order that I may complete the registration CD off to the AASC offices before their deadline on 22 August.

## **QUESTION RE PAYMENT OF HOST FEES**

Host Fees are quarterly fees that are payable within a specific quarter. Should parents of normally billed accounts (Not mission fees) pay before the end of the month of the quarter (For instance in this quarter the end of July), they will receive a discount on their accounts.

## **REMINDER - PACE ORDERS !!!**

The Academy will order from the ACE Warehouse 5<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. I therefore need to be the latest by the previous day in order for me to place the order and place it with ACE by Lunch Time on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

Also remember that I need the amount for the orders into the WCHEA Orders account preferably by the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month. Please place the order with ACE as the ACE Warehouse has processed the last few month's orders sometime between the 15<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. I therefore ask that payments into the WCHEA Orders account please not be made by cheque, otherwise I can only cash the cheque against the cheque and then everyone that has an order will have to wait for their order.
