CFAM/OBEST TESTS

Friday 28 September : Cape Town

As in the past, I will only administer these tests will be scored by Dr. Holman. The results will be sent to me, and I then relay the results to each school individually.

No preparation is necessary for these tests. Students will be tested on general knowledge, and they will be according to the assessment standards and outcomes of the R.N.C.S.
