Please take note that the Early Bird registration for the All Africa Student Convention (Senior Convention) is 25 July, (R1060) and the final Registration date is 5 September. (R1170).

As you are aware, the posters were all sent in last quarter's Accelerator that ACE sent out. The Convention dates are 7-11 December at the University of the Free State.

OBEST/CFAM tests from 8-12 September.

Last year's OBEST/CFAM tests were completed during the September holidays. I have scheduled them for the above week during the school quarter, since a few parents could not have the students tested during the school holidays last year.

Remember that all Gr. 3, 6/7 and Grade 9 students are to be tested and these tests can then be used when you apply for registration of each student into the next phase with the Western Cape Education Department.

If there is a need for the tests, I will again Travel to Beaufort West, Hartenbos, Robertson and Cape Town in order to administer these tests, with the tests being administered for a complete day at each venue.

The costs for these tests will be R150 per student tested. According to my calculations, there are more than 40 students who are eligible to be tested. I have thus included fuel costs in this price, provided that more than 40 students are being tested, and fuel does not increase over R10.00 per liter. Should these assumptions not be correct, I will have to alter these costs.
