**KNOW THE FACTS ABOUT
EDUCATION AT HOME**

- A parent wishing to teach his or her child of school-going age at home must first obtain approval from the Head of the Western Cape Education Department.
- Applications must be made by 30 September of the year prior to the start of the new school year.
- Approval must be obtained per learning phase: Foundation Phase (Grade 1-3), Intermediate Phase (Grade 4-6) or Senior Phase (Grade 7-9).

- An approved curriculum, in line with the National Curriculum Statement, must be followed.
- Learners who wish to continue with their education after Grade 9 must write and pass the Grade 9 exit examinations at a public school or a registered independent school.
- Learners who wish to complete the Further Education and Training phase (Grade 10-12) must enroll at a public or registered independent school.
- The requirements set out in the policy for the Registration of Learners for Home Education will apply.
