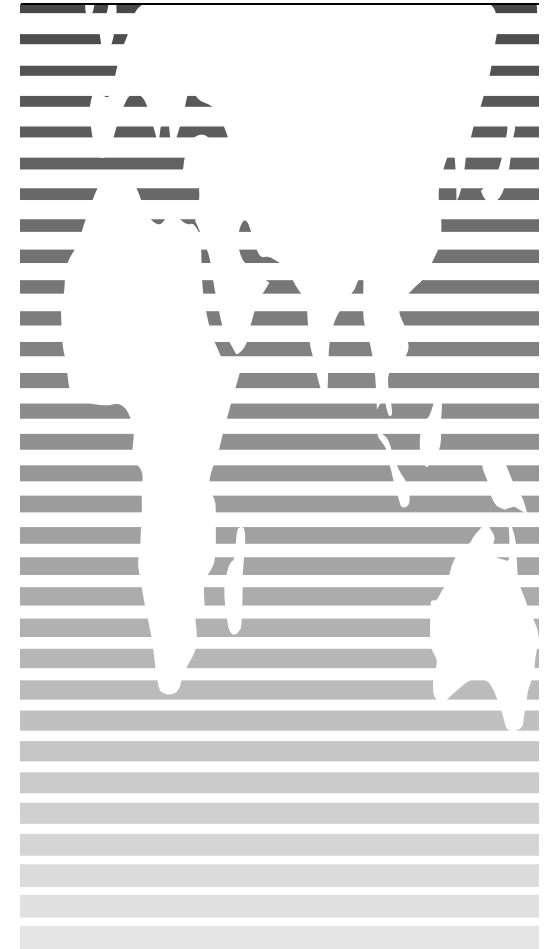

C SAMS PROGRAM

Susan and I acquired the C SAMS (Christian Schools Administration and Management System) during the first quarter, and I attended a training course

on the System on Saturday, 26 February 2011.

I had time scheduled during the entire last week to get the program up and running. This meant creating a new database, setting up the students' S.P.C.'s, setting up the financial side of the System – which can be exported to Pastel should we so desire, etc.

I am printing the first batch of accounts today, 1 April. PLEASE TAKE NOTE that you will be getting two printed accounts types in the post next week. The first one will be the “old” one, and the next one will be the new one. Both the amounts to be paid should obviously be the same - if I did everything right – ha, ha, - but the only reason I am sending you the “old” accounts as well, is because the new account will start with a balance brought forward, which is specified on the “old” account, since all the transactions for the past quarter since Dec '10 has been specified on the “old” account.

You are welcome to contact me should anything not be clear. Remember that should you pay the amount due before the end of April, you are welcome to subtract R50 off the account. I will then credit your account. Should you not subtract the R50, I will assume that you are blessing us with an extra R50. This arrangement is not applicable after the 30st of April and also not on mission status accounts. Your account will specify if it is a mission status account.

- Postage at the Post Office to send orders to you amounts to R4424.23.
- Many home schools don't immediately check the orders they receive from me. I attach an excel sheet to most e mails sent to you in order for you to check your order when it arrives. That way you can also see which items you are renting, and which you bought from ACE. Please check your orders immediately against the excel sheet when you receive it, and let me know immediately (per email) if there are inconsistencies. I try my best not to make mistakes, but unfortunately I sometimes do. If home schools contact me about a challenge a long time after the order was received, it is almost impossible to solve the problem
